Re: SR 162 Watermain Replacement Project

Dear Property Owner,

Your property has been identified as being in the general vicinity of an upcoming VWD project (see project summary below). This notice is to inform you that you may start seeing construction related activity for this project around the end of April. The project was awarded to Reed Trucking and Excavating, Inc. who will make every effort to minimize the impacts to traffic and/or access to any of the properties. The District or Contractor will notify you at least 48 hours in advance of any significant impacts.

The SR 162 Water Main Replacement Project is broken into two phases. The first phase will install approximately 1,460 feet of 12-inch diameter ductile iron water pipe from 122<sup>nd</sup> St E to just south of Military Road E. The second phase will install approximately 3,530 feet of 12-inch ductile iron water pipe from 115<sup>th</sup> St E to just south of 103<sup>rd</sup> St E. All work will take place in the northbound shoulder of SR 162. Both phases will replace fire hydrants and service connections to customers. Driveways and vegetation disturbed during this project will be restored.

The Contractor will start mobilizing equipment for the first phase on or about April 24<sup>th</sup>. Traffic control will also be set up that week. Pipe installation will start on or about May 1 and continue until the end of the month. The contractor will install asphalt patching and restore vegetation along SR 162 in the first week of June.

The Contractor will move their equipment to the second phase of the project during the week of June 5<sup>th</sup>. Traffic control will also be set up that week. Pipe installation will start on or about June 13<sup>th</sup> and continue until the end of August. The Contractor will install asphalt patching and restore vegetation along SR 162 in the first two weeks of September. That will complete the project.
